Completion by Design – North Carolina Guilford Technical Community College



- Over 40% of new students test into two or more developmental education subjects
- To significantly increase completion rates, we must move students into programs of study as effectively and efficiently as possible.
- Data from our online COMPASS Review indicates that a high percentage of students are placed in courses below their skill level

Completion by Design – Strategy

- Leveraging work done through the North Carolina DEI State Policy Committee and Multiple Measures of Placement Committee
- Working with CCRC/Clive Belfield
- Multiple placement measures are part of a larger strategy to accelerate students through developmental education
- Focusing on high school GPA
- Working through policy channels to receive waivers and change policy
