- Funded by the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation
- Goals are to reduce or eliminate the need for developmental education
- Includes four major initiatives:
 - Boot Camp
 - Accelerated Math
 - Accelerated English
 - Early Support Program



BOOT CAMP FOR ENTERING STUDENTS

- One-week, 3 hours a day
- Brush up of basic skills just prior to start of term
- Started with math, added English & reading

MATH ACADEMY (MATH MODULES)

- Covers basic arithmetic and introductory algebra
- Students proceed at their own pace, but work to deadlines
- Pre-test allows students to demonstrate competence and skip modules
- Must take paper & pencil tests and comprehensive final
- Staffed by instructors, professional tutors and university students.

ACCELERATED MATH LESSONS LEARNED

- More structure is needed
- Students expected to come at scheduled times
- 3. Students expected to adhere to minimum deadlines
- 4. Students given additional deadlines/goals in order to complete content from two courses
- 5. Systems approach is key



MATH ACADEMY CHANGES

- Moving towards minimesters three classes that contain 2 modules each
- One book and one access code for all Developmental Math classes
- Add in-house video lectures
- Create a stand-alone workbook that contains notes and problem sets
- Students and instructors will be blockscheduled for ease of moving through the curriculum faster

- Offers students who test just below collegelevel English opportunity to take a tutorialbased developmental English class as a corequisite to college-level English composition
- 8-10 "pilot" students in ENG 111 along with 14 students already at "college-level"

ACCELERATED ENGLISH CHANGES

- 1. Own course number
- 2. Connection to WritePlacer pilot

- Summer Institute to Scale DEI
- Small teams to build maps for highest level DEV students
- Contextualizing DEV and Gatekeeper Courses
